

Job Description: WATERSHED SANITATION WORKER

Purpose of position:

Reporting to the Supervisor Watershed Security this position is primarily responsible for the monitoring, cleaning and servicing of toilet facilities within the GVRD watershed lands.

Major Duties: *(The duties described are intended to be representative of the position and are not to be considered as all-inclusive).*

Assembles, cleans, moves and maintains sanitary facilities as required for all work locations in the GVRD watersheds and LSCR when required.

Ensures that products used conform to MSDS. Stays apprised of appropriate and safe cleaning, deodorizing and disinfecting products for use in GVRD watersheds.

Ensures that all individuals entering or working in the GVRD Watersheds have an entry permit and are on official business.

Checks the record of all persons entering and leaving the GVRD Watersheds to ensure that all entrants are accounted for at the end of shift and provides communication with other GVRD staff and hourly contractors working alone in the watersheds as per the working alone procedures.

Maintains clearance records and submits daily reports as required.

Enforces the Watershed Regulations, working in conjunction with other Watershed Management staff.

Patrols the GVRD Watersheds, relying on a variety of travel modes (i.e. vehicle, bike, boat, and helicopter when required, or on foot).

Locates and deals with trespassers in a diplomatic but firm manner.

Escorts those on approved watershed business that do not have the required entry permit.

Works with other Watershed staff in checking and reporting road conditions slides, fires and any other situation relating to unusual weather conditions.

Communicates and works with other watershed staff to ensure that all petroleum products are stored correctly and that the proper procedures are in place and being followed to prevent any contamination.

Takes water samples as required.

Performs routine installation, monitoring and maintenance of portable video surveillance equipment at appropriate locations and is responsible for the daily operation of the electronic entrance gate and video surveillance equipment where such equipment is installed.

Checks and repairs perimeter fences. Installs and replaces signage as required.

Maintains office and perimeter grounds.

Provides assistance to Watershed Operations staff as required.

Performs standby for watershed activities as required.

Participates in emergency response, including forest fire fighting, petroleum spill clean up, road patrols and landslide clean up.
